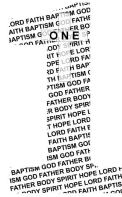

Hello Chris

This past Sunday, we started our discussion about the Holy Spirit with an overview of who the Holy Spirit is.

We discussed and listed who we understand the Holy Spirit to be and we studied several Bible verses about the Holy Spirit. We heard the Holy Spirit described as many things such as: advocate, counselor, comforter, helper, intercessor, strengthener, teacher, and guide. We learned that Jesus never referred to the Holy Spirit as "it" or some kind of abstract entity but as a person that you can interact with. We learned that the Holy Spirit is always with us but He will never force himself upon us.

Some of the scriptures that we read helped describe the Holy Spirit's personality or character. He has a mind in **Romans 8:27** and a will in **1 Corinthians 12:11**. He shows emotions such as love and joy in **Romans 15:30** and **Galatians 5:22**. In **Acts 9:31**, He comforts us. In **Hebrews 3:7** and **1 Timothy 4:1** He speaks clearly to us. He teaches us in **1 Corinthians 2:13**. We found in **Ephesians 4:30** that He can feel sorrow and can be insulted in **Hebrews 10:29**.

We learned that there is a lot more to the Holy Spirit than many of us ever thought. Even Jesus could not have performed his ministry without first having the Holy Spirit come upon Him.

We recalled our teaching about friends and said that the Holy Spirit shares many of the same attributes as a "Best Friend" and he wants to have a relationship with us like a "Best Friend".

YOUR HOMEWORK this week is to ask the Holy Spirit to reveal himself to you, to show you who he is and to start a real relationship with him.

Next week, we will talk more about our relationship with the Holy Spirit and about the Holy Spirit's relationship in the Trinity.
