This past Sunday, we continued our discussion about the Holy Spirit with a review of the character and attributes of the Holy Spirit, the Trinity and how the Holy Spirit is part of it and how the Holy Spirit is the "Spirit of Life".

This week we talked about depending on the Holy Spirit. We started by defining what depending on somebody means. We said that it means to rely on somebody or something else for aid, support, etc.

We talked about the different people we depend on for various things and asked if the Disciples depended on anyone. We agreed that they depended on Jesus but after Jesus was taken up to heaven, they then received power when the Holy Spirit came upon them. They then depended on the Holy Spirit to help them accomplish their mission of spreading the Gospel and building the Church while performing miracles and healing with the power of the Holy Spirit in them.

We said that even Jesus depended on the Holy Spirit while He was here as one of us. Jesus did not start his ministry until after being baptized and receiving the Holy Spirit. As a man, He could not have accomplished His mission on Earth without depending on the Holy Spirit.

Jesus depended on the Holy Spirit throughout his ministry in everything He said, everything He did and it was the Holy Spirit whom raised Him from the dead after being crucified.
