This week, we talked about kindness. We said that kindness was a fruit of the Spirit which means it is something that should grow out of our life as we live according to God's Word.

We talked about kindness as an action and then looked at **Colossians 3:12** where it says that we should "clothe ourselves with kindness". It tells us that kindness should not be just a single action that is completed and forgotten but should be something that we wrap all around us and wear all day long.

We looked at kindness in our Words, in our Actions and in our Attitude. It's easy to be unkind with our words but we learned it is just as easy to be kind with our words. All we have to do is take a moment to think about what we are about to say and if it's not kind, then just don't say it.

We also learned that it is just as easy to be kind with our actions by taking a moment to think about whether what we are about to do is kind and if it's not, then just don't do it.

We agreed that the hardest thing to do is to always have kindness in our attitude. When someone gets on our nerves or is unkind to us, the last thing that we are thinking about is being kind to them but it is the one thing that we should be thinking about. Having kindness in our attitude is the most important because it will help lead us to kind words and actions.

Job 6:14 tells us that if we're not being kind to those around us, we are disrespecting God. As Christians, we are lead to live a Christ-like life as an example of Jesus to others. We said that we may be the only example of Jesus that some people ever see and how we treat others speaks to others about our faith in Jesus.

We'll start up again with regular rehearsals in the new year. When someone is unkind, we can't possibly know what they are going through or how our kindness to them may positively impact their life. It can never hurt to be kind to someone but it CAN definitely hurt to be unkind to someone.

We said that being kind to others may not be the easiest thing to do but it is ALWAYS the right thing to do. When we have trouble being kind to someone, we can always ask the Holy Spirit to help us because God wants us to be kind and to share His love with others. We may even sometimes hear the Holy Spirit specifically telling us to be kind in some situations where we may not feel like being kind.

We then talked about how kindness is contagious. When we are kind to others, it tends to cause them to be kind to others as well. Being kind also makes it easier to be kind until we don't even have to think about being kind and we are clothed in kindness all day long.


