



matter what, spending time with God needs to be your number one priority (Praying, reading and listening to His word). If that means you have to get up a little earlier, then wake up earlier. If that means you have to sacrifice something extra, then so be it. Who better to consult with about how best to spend your time than the creator of all time?

2. **Prioritize Things In Your Life:** There are things that you have to do, things that you want to do and things that God has called you to do. Without having things in priority, it's easy to leave important things undone. One of the best ways to remember your priorities is to get a planner or a calendar and write down when things are due, when you need to study, etc. Get a planner app or use the calendar in your phone.
3. **Hold Yourself Accountable:** After you've prioritized and created your schedule, pray over it. Ask God to help you achieve all you need to achieve in the time that you need to achieve it and ask Him to help you manage your time better. Then find somebody that will hold you accountable to your schedule. It can be a leader, teacher, parent or even a friend who is also trying to manage their time better. Weekly reminder texts can help keep you on track.

Without priorities and time management, things can easily pile up fast and cause you to be overwhelmed. But, if you're prepared by having the right mindset, the mindset that knows God has blessed you with this life, He loves you more than anything and He wants to see you succeed in the life He has planned for you and you want to make the most of your time that you can, your life will be so much better for you.
