Greetings!

Last week we left off with Moses talking with God and with God telling Moses that he would be the one to confront Pharaoh and free the Israelites from their slavery in Egypt.

This week, we said that Moses had no idea how he was going to accomplish this seemingly impossible task given to him by God.

We read and talked about all of the 10 plagues that God used to convince Pharaoh to let His people go. We discussed how Pharaoh's own pride would not allow him to admit that the God of Moses was God and was greater than himself and all the Egyptian gods.

Even through the plagues, we can see God's grace and mercy as He gave Pharaoh countless chances to repent and let the Israelites go but he continued to refuse until he finally gave in after the 10th and final plague which killed all of the 1st born, including Pharaoh's own son.

We then discussed the parallels and foreshadowing of the Passover where the blood of the pure and perfect lamb sacrifice marked God's people and saved the Israelites from death. In the same way, Jesus, the sinless, spotless and perfect Lamb of God, was sacrificed to save us from the death of our sin with His blood on the cross.

We talked about the amazing lengths God went to in order to save and protect His chosen people in Egypt and compared it to the amazing sacrifice Jesus made for us when He paid the price of death to save us from our sin. Jesus gave His life on the cross so that we don't have to.

God will always do whatever it takes to protect His chosen people and through the blood of Jesus, we are marked as His chosen people.
