Greetings!

This week we mentioned the phrase "seeing is believing" and how very often our sense of sight can be deceiving, such as with "optical illusions". But, Jesus knew that His Disciples needed the assurance by seeing, with their own eyes, His resurrection if they were to fully embrace their mission on Earth after His ascension.

We discussed that without their full belief in Christ's resurrection, the Disciples would have never built the Church and spread Jesus' words to others. After Jesus' death the Disciples were terrified that they too would be killed for following Jesus and none of them actually expected the resurrection that Jesus had promised them.

Jesus not only appeared to His Disciples to prove His resurrection, He spent the next 40 days with them teaching them what would be their most important lesson.

Jesus told His Disciples that they are blessed because they saw and believe yet those who have not seen and still believe (us) are just as blessed.

He told them that He was sending them as His Father had sent Him. God did not send Jesus as a man to save the world on His own because only the power of God can bring salvation. Jesus did not start His Earthly ministry until after He was baptized and received The Holy Spirit.

In the same way, Jesus did not ask His Disciples, and us, to spread the Gospel and make Disciples of all nations on our own. It is The Holy Spirit working through us that brings salvation to the world.

We saw in the Disciples' last words to Jesus that they were still concerned about the immediate, physical salvation or freedom from Rome for their people. Jesus basically tells them to not worry about what God has planned in His own time because they have much more important work to do.

Jesus taught them a different understanding of God's promise.

We finished with a challenge to ask The Holy Spirit to show us how we can share what we know about Jesus with somebody who needs to hear it and then be ready for God to place that somebody in our life to use us to bring others to Him.
