Greetings!

This week we looked at the book of Revelation and what John seeks to explain to the church as he describes the vision he received from God.

John is writing in symbolism throughout the book of Revelation similar to the way we text in shorthand today. The majority of Revelation is peculiar and majestic to our modern ears because John, a human, was trying to describe the things of heaven in the terms and symbols of that time period.

We began our discussion by reading Revelation 1:9-20. Verses 9-20 describe a vision given to John and specifically we see three truths that we have seen of Jesus throughout our study of God's Word in our previous lessons.

Truth 1: Jesus stands ready to forgive.

Truth 2: Jesus, the light of the world, calls the Church to be His light.

Truth 3: The Word of God cannot be silenced.

We looked at each truth and discussed the symbolism expressed in the vision that supports the statement. Thank you to all the the students for great participation in making the discussions lively and interesting! We had so much discussion we were only able to make it through half the lesson!

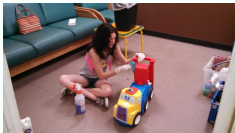

All for just \$35 each!

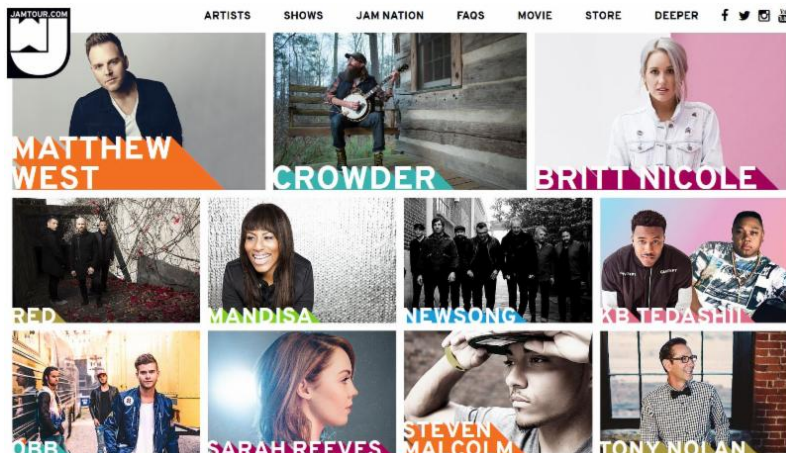
We will meet at LWA at 2:30pm and travel together to the Glendale Arena. Concert is typically over by 11PM.
