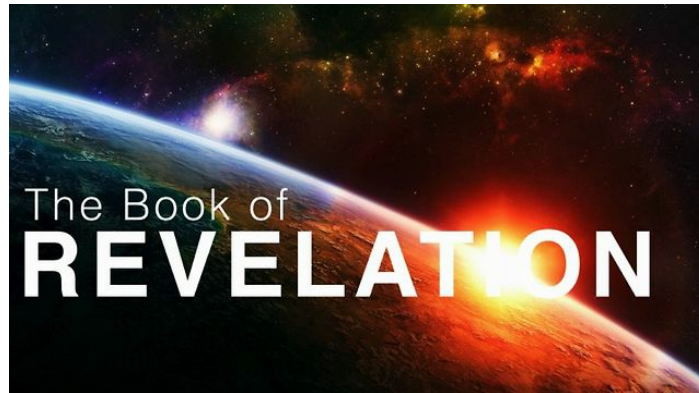
Community Service

This week we finished up our 52 week series looking at the Thread of Jesus and the Gospel throughout the entire Bible.

We started talking about the book of Revelation and asked what we typically think about when we hear people talk about the book of Revelation. We made a list of what we thought it might look like at the "end of the world". We then talked about and made a list of what the beginning of the world looked like back in Genesis 1.

We started our last lesson in **Revelation 21:1-8** where John is talking about the coming of the "New Heaven" and the "New Earth". We noted that John's description seemed to match the list we had made about the beginning of the world with God dwelling with Adam and Eve, No sadness, no pain, no death, etc.

We saw that the "end of the world" as described in Revelation seems to be very much like the "beginning of the world".

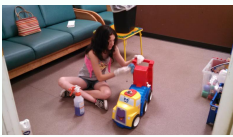
We also saw that all this will come to those who believe and who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior while divine judgement and the fiery lake of burning sulfur awaited those who do not believe. We said that our own judgement already came on the cross through Jesus' death and resurrection.

We said the main point was that for those who believe, the "end" is really the "beginning" meaning that God will restore us back to our perfect relationship with Him as we were created

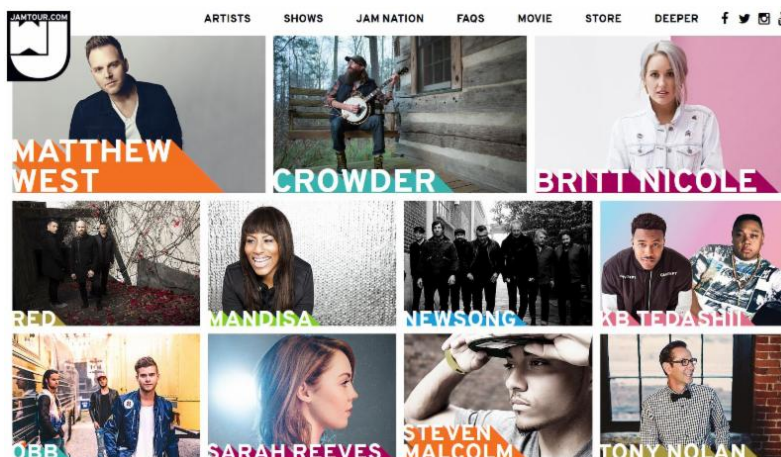
All for just \$35 each!
