Last week we asked "What are you doing with what God has given you?"

We started in **John 10:10** where Jesus tells us that He came that we may have an **abundant life**.

We talked about what that means and said that we clearly were not created to just sit and stare at the wall (**or our phones**) our whole lives just waiting around for eternity to happen. Our life is created to be an amazing adventure designed and planned by God for His Joy and for our Joy as well.

First, we made sure to make very clear that this is not about our Salvation. Our Salvation is a gift from God through Jesus and what He did for us. It is given to each of us and all we have to do is accept it by believing and receiving Jesus into our life and into our heart. There's nothing else we need to do and there's nothing we can ever do to have it taken away.

With that made clear, we looked at **Matthew 25:14-30** to get an idea of exactly what we're supposed to be doing while we're here as Jesus teaches in the **Parable of the Talents**.

We saw that the **"Master"** was leaving and he entrusted his wealth to several of his servants. He gave each of them a different number of bags of gold or "Talents" according to their ability. We said that the Master knew each of the servants had different abilities and therefore received different Talents entrusted to them.

We saw that two of the servants put the money to work and were able to double the value given to them but the third servant was afraid and hid the gold entrusted to him in the ground.

Upon the Masters return, he saw what the two servants had done with what they were given and said, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things. Come and

Foster Care Teens Personal Care Items

1 Youth is continuing to collect "Personal Care Items" for the teens in foster care throughout the year. Items for both male and female teens are being collected in the two bins just outside our youth room. These items will be sorted into personal bags and given to DCS to be distributed to teens who may not even have their own tooth brush or comb.

Whenever you're out shopping for your own personal care items such as soap, deodorant, tooth paste, feminine hygiene items or when you see the "travel size" shampoo, mouthwash, etc., pick up a few extra items and drop them in the bins.

Help share God's love by letting these teens know that somebody really does care about them. share your master's happiness!"

When the Master saw what the 3rd servant had done with what he was given the Master called him a "wicked, lazy servant!" and took what he had saying, "whoever has will be given more and whoever does not have will have it taken from them." He then said to throw the worthless servant outside into the darkness.

We said that the underlying theme in this parable was **FAITH**. Jesus was saying that whoever has faith, like the 1st two servants, will be given even more but those who do not have faith, like the third servant, will have nothing.

We also see, in this parable, that when we have the faith to use what God has given each of us, our Talents, we bring God happiness which He then shares with us.

So, we asked what it is that we're supposed to do with our Talents. The answer was found in **Matthew 5 and 28**. Jesus said we are the light of the world and we are to shine our light so that others may see our good deeds and glorify God.

Jesus also told us that we are to make disciples of all nations teaching them to obey everything He commanded. We also saw in **John 14:12** that we will do works even greater than the works Jesus did. We talked about the book of Acts where we can see the Disciples doing exactly that, teaching the word of God, healing the sick, driving out demons, etc. just as Jesus said they would be able to.

So, to summarize, we are each given unique talents by God, according to our ability, to be used to help build the Kingdom of God by doing good works in faith.

When we stand in front of the throne of God, as believers in Christ, we will not be judged like the unbelievers, for our sin, as Jesus already paid the price for our salvation. Our place in Heaven is reserved. But, God will want to know how we used the talents that He gave us.

When we tell Him, will He say "Well done, good and faithful servant!...Come and share your master's happiness" or will you be more like the 3rd servant who had no faith and was therefore too afraid to use what was given him?

We said that your talents may be many different things and you may not even know what your talent is. We talked about many people in the Bible who were in just this situation and we saw that God gives us our talents according to our ability, even if we don't know what that ability is. God never sets us up to fail and He will always equip us to succeed in whatever He has planned for us.
