Last week we looked at our identity regarding our faith and trust in God especially during dark or difficult times in our lives.

We said that it's easy to have faith and trust in God when things are going well but sometimes it's also easy to forget God's goodness

when things don't seem to going our way. Sometimes we not only forget everything God has promised, we may even start to actually blame God for our troubles.

We looked at one of the examples of having faith and trust in God in the story of Joseph found in **Genesis 37-50**.

We looked at the story of Joseph and his dream that his family was bowing to him signified by wheat. We saw his brothers wanting to kill him then selling him into slavery in Egypt where he was falsely accused by Potiphar's wife and thrown into prison while all the time, his father thought he had been killed by animals as his brothers had said.

All through Joseph's darkest times, he never lost his faith or trust in God's promise to him nor did his father, Jacob, ever lose his faith in what God had promised him about his family.

We then saw God interpret Pharaoh's dream, through Joseph, that there would be 7 years of plenty followed by 7 years of famine and Pharaoh then making Joseph 2nd in command over all Egypt to consequently save the people from famine.

Joseph saw his dream realized 20 years after his brothers sold him into slavery when they came to him (not knowing who he was) and bowed down to him pleading for food.

We said that not only did Joseph not lose his faith in God, he also remembered to give God all the glory for what he was able to do through all of Joseph's troubles.

We said that while God does not cause our troubles, He can use our negative circumstances to complete His good plan
