Bible verse of the week



are thinking that this pandemic we are currently in is the "End of the world".

We started by mentioning a dozen or so other times when people thought it was the end of the world. Such as other recent pandemics, Mayan calendar in 2012, Y2K, various evangelists, Halley's comet in 1910, the 'great flood' of 1524, and even the Black Plague in the mid 1300's.

We said that for hundreds of centuries, religious leaders, scientists, and sometimes just plain crazy people have been predicting the 'end of the world'. One thing that we immediately noticed is that, regardless of all their predictions, we are all still here.

We talked a bit about humans seemingly being obsessed with the end of the world and **WHEN** it will happen.

We took a look in the Bible to see if we could find what Jesus had to say about the 'end of the world'. We found Jesus discussing the 'end of the world' with His Disciples in **Mark 13:1-37**.

We read about Jesus telling the Disciples all about the things that will happen at that time and we noticed that even the Disciples wanted to know **WHEN** it would happen.

Jesus finally gets around to the **WHEN** toward the end of the chapter and He very clearly tells them "**no one knows**". He repeats it more than once in several different ways that we must "Be alert" because we will not know **WHEN** the time will come.

He even goes into an illustration in **Mark 13:34-37** to further help make His point crystal clear that no one will know so we must always be ready for it to happen at anytime and we should not be deceived by those who do claim to know.

So, we said it should be no surprise to us that all these predictions never came true. Jesus very clearly tells us that Nobody will know.

We then talked about why we, as humans, are so interested in knowing **WHEN** it will happen and asked how it might change our lives if we did know **WHEN** the world would end. We talked about what we would do if we knew and asked if it would be a good thing to know **WHEN** the end of the world would actually happen.

We wondered why Jesus wouldn't have just asked His Father for the answer and then tell us so we would all know and we could stop asking or predicting when it would happen.

We talked about what God really wants us to be focused on between now and then. As Christians, we are commanded by Jesus to "make disciples of all nations" (**Matthew 28**). We should be focused on sharing God's message of Love and Grace and Mercy with the entire world so that ALL can be saved.

We talked about what we would be focused on instead if we knew the time and date and all the fear and stress it would bring us.
