"Personal Care Items" for teens in foster care



I have called you by name

A few weeks ago we introduced and finished up episode 1 of **The Chosen TV series**, "I have called you by name". We said that we read a lot about what the Disciples said and did in the Bible but we sometimes really don't get who the Disciples were, the lives they lived, their character, and what it really means to be chosen, by Jesus, as His Disciple in the 1st Century.

We discussed how this series was not intended to change or replace God's Word or even to pretend to be God's Word but is to create a dialog and give backstories, based on Scripture, Historical & Cultural information, and sometimes on what just makes sense in the context of the time. It's a story of Jesus as told from the perspective of those who first knew Him.

Bible verse of the week

Isaiah 43:1 (NKJV)
But now, thus says the
Lord, who created you,
O Jacob, And He who
formed you, O Israel:
"Fear not, for I have
redeemed you; I have
called you by your
name; You are mine."

We said these backstories can help us better understand what life was like in the 1st Century and can help us to identify with the character and personalities of those writing scripture and of those who chose to follow Jesus and even of those who chose not to follow Him.

For example, we know from the Bible that Matthew was a Tax Collector but it may be hard to understand what it really meant to live as a Jewish tax collector, how it affected his personal decision to follow Jesus, his personal interactions with Jesus, and even how it may have affected his writing about Jesus.

In the first episode we got an introduction of what it was like to live as a Jew under Roman rule in the 1st Century. We were introduced to Mary Magdalene, Nicodemus, Matthew, Simon (Peter), and his brother Andrew.

We discussed who they were, their character, and what each of their lives were like before ever meeting Jesus. We talked about what life was like in general at that time and talked about the relationships between the Romans, the Pharisees, and the Jewish people.

We start episode 2 this Sunday the 14th at 9:30
