Shabbat

A couple of weeks ago we finished up episode 2 of **The Chosen TV series**, "Shabbat". We had more discussion on the development of the characters of Mary, Nicodemus, Matthew, Simon (Peter), and Andrew as well as the introduction of two new ones, James and Thaddeus.

We discussed the Jewish tradition of celebrating Shabbat or the day of rest and the importance of resting on the Sabbath day and worshiping God.

We also discussed the different ways each of the characters Mary, Nicodemus, Matthew, and Simon (Peter) celebrated Shabbat and what it showed us, including which Shabbat dinner Jesus chose to attend.

Nicodemus = Very fancy and formal, law/rules based dinner with other Pharisees.

Mary = Very informal and simple from her heart with friends and literally anyone who chose to come by (including Jesus). We talked about why Jesus would choose Mary's dinner to attend. Jesus came for us all, not only for the righteous.

Matthew = Ate dinner alone with his dog. More life of a Jewish Tax Collector

Simon = Fished (worked) desperately trying to fix his and Andrew's problems on his own.

We also discussed Nicodemus' and the Pharisees response to the miracle of Mary's reported redemption from demon possession compared to Mary's response.

Nicodemus and the Pharisees were primarily focused on HOW it happened and WHO was responsible for performing the miracle while Mary did not understand how or who and was simply grateful that it happened.

Mary's response to Nicodemus was simply, "I was one way... and now I am completely different... And the thing that happened in between... was Him." (Jesus)

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We start episode 3 this Sunday the 11th at 9:30
