






Wednesday Nights at 7:00pm


both male and female teens are being collected in the bin just outside our youth room.

Bible verse of the week

Mark 8:34-36 (TPT)

³⁴ Jesus had his disciples and the crowd gather around him. And he said to them: "If you truly want to follow me, you should at once completely disown your own life. And you must be willing to share my cross and experience it as your own, as you continually surrender to my ways. ³⁵ For if you let your life go for my sake and for the sake of the gospel, you will continually experience true life. But if you choose to keep your life for yourself, you will forfeit what you try to keep. ³⁶ For what use is it to gain all the wealth and power of this world, with everything it could offer you, at the cost of your own life?



What is the truth?

This past Sunday, we started a new series on Christian Apologetics which is basically defending our faith against objections and misrepresentations. Before we could start defending our faith, we had to first understand **truth**.

We talked about all of the half-truths and even total lies that surround us on a daily basis that make it difficult to tell what is the truth.

We also talked about how the world tells us that there are multiple truths. They say truth is a matter of perspective and one persons truth may not be another persons truth and anyone who thinks differently is closed minded.

We looked at the example showing a 6 or a 9 and agreed that both cannot be right as the cartoon says. There can be only one truth. But, how do we know which one is the truth? We came up with three methods.

- 1. Look at the context it is used in
- 2. Look for clues that may suggest proper perspective
- 3. Ask the person who put it there (the creator)

We agreed that the 3rd option would be the best as the person who put it there would certainly know the truth.

We then said that we can use these same methods to determine what is the truth in the world around us with the 3rd option being to ask the creator, God.

We also said that it's sometimes even more difficult to tell the difference between our own feelings and the truth. It seems that the world is more concerned with the pursuit of happiness rather than the pursuit of truth.

We said that our feelings can easily become what drives us, motivates us, and can impact our life decisions.

We looked at **Mark 8:34-35** where Jesus is basically telling His Disciples they must separate themselves from their own selfish worldly desires and feelings in order to follow

Him. He told them if they try to hold onto these things they will lose them because they are only temporary and they distract from God's truth. When they separate themselves to follow Him they will live in the truth for eternity.

We discussed how the story about the Rich Young Ruler in **Matthew 19** really had nothing to do with whether rich people can go to heaven but rather how difficult it can be to let go of our worldly desires & feelings to follow Jesus and find the truth, which the man could not do.

We talked about how our feelings and emotions change all the time but the truth never changes. We said that even "facts" can change over time but the truth never does. For example: At one time, it was a "fact" that the Sun orbited the Earth yet now, the "fact" is that the Earth orbits the Sun but, the Truth was the same then as it is now.

We also talked about some times when we've made decisions based on our feelings or emotions and how that turned out.

We said that our feelings and emotions are not really bad and it's even good to have them. The problem happens when we allow them to rule our lives or decisions and when we allow them to replace God's truth.

Next Sunday we'll talk more about what the truth is, why it's important to know the truth, and some resources God has given us to help us know what the truth is.
