The Chosen series. We learned about who the Zealots were and were introduced to Simon the Zealot who would later become one of Jesus' Disciples.

We also talked about the Pool of Bethesda, in Jerusalem, and were introduced to Jesse (not named in the Bible) who had been paralyzed from a young age. He spent his entire adult life lying by the pool hoping to somehow get to the stirred waters to be healed.

We learned and talked about the "Feast of Tabernacles" which is what brought Jesus and the Disciples to Jerusalem.

We saw Shmuel, the Pharisee who caused Jesus trouble in Capernaum in episode 6 of season 1, teaching in the streets of Jerusalem about False Prophets.

We then talked about how the Zealots used scripture to back up and justify their attempts to kill and violently overthrow the Romans, to cleanse Israel.

One of those verses they used was from Psalm 69:9 where David talks about having "zeal" for God's house. We said that having "zeal" is to have great dedication or enthusiasm for something and to be passionately motivated. We noted that Jesus could be said to have "zeal" for God's house as well yet we don't see Him killing people or even attempting to dispel the Romans from Israel in the name of God.

We discussed this as a good example of how important it is for us to read AND to understand Bible verses in the context in which they were written, to know God's character, and to listen to the Holy Spirit for guidance. We agreed that the Zealot's actions clearly did not align with God's Word or with His character yet they passionately believed they were doing God's work.

We talked about some groups of people who still do this today and how many times people will take specific pieces of scripture, out of context, to help validate their actions rather than the more difficult task of aligning their actions with the Word of God instead.

We also talked about how the Bible verse from, **Zephaniah 3:19** kept showing up for Simon. We talked about how sometimes we may get a specific Bible verse that just pops into our head for no apparent reason or maybe a verse that we seem to keep seeing or hearing wherever we go, maybe it's even a line in a song or a specific memory that keeps showing up.

We said that this could be God's Word speaking to us and

how it's important to listen and to determine what it is that God may be trying to tell us through His Holy Spirit remembering to make sure it aligns with God's character.


The first 1/2 of this episode is mostly just setting everything up to really start to happen in the very exciting 2nd half.
