Mary made it back to camp with Simon and Matthew where they had just found out about Herod putting John the Baptizer in prison for life.

This Week's Bible Verse

Mark 2:23-28

²³ One Sabbath Jesus was going through the grain fields, and as his disciples walked along, they began to pick some heads of grain. ²⁴ The Pharisees said to him, "Look, why are they doing what is unlawful on the Sabbath?" ²⁵ He answered, "Have you never read what David did when he and his companions were hungry and in need? ²⁶ In the days of Abiathar the high priest, he entered the house of God and ate the consecrated bread. which is lawful only for priests to eat. And he also gave some to his companions." ²⁷ Then he said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. ²⁸ So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."

<u>Visit our</u> <u>website here!</u> The first thing Mary did was to meet with Jesus. We noted that Jesus did not scold her or punish her or start telling her everything she did wrong. He didn't even make her feel guilty for causing everyone to worry about her. He simply said, "It's good to have you back."

Mary was so ashamed and so sorry for what she did that she couldn't even look at Jesus. She said that He redeemed her and she just through it all away. Jesus told her that it wouldn't be much of a redemption if she could just lose it in a day. He asked her, "did you think you would never sin again" after being redeemed?

Mary said that she can't live up to it and can never repay Him. Jesus said, "that is true, but you don't have to." He told her all He and The Father want is her heart, which she has already given, and the rest will come later. Then He told Mary to look up to Him and He said, "I forgive you, it's over".

The 2nd part of what He said is just as important as the 1st part. When we are forgiven, it's over. God does not hold it against us and neither should we.

We said that the whole story with Mary in both episodes 5 & 6 shows us that even though we have been saved and reborn in a new spirit, we can still fall back into our old ways, make mistakes, stray from God, and not only will God always be with us, He will rescue His stray sheep to forgive us and tell us to try it again.

We said no matter where we are, what we do, how lost we are, or how bad we mess up, we can always go BOLDLY before The Father to confess our sin and be forgiven in the name of Jesus. We can always look forward to Jesus telling us, "It's good to have you back."

The ending of this episode deals with Jesus healing on the Sabbath again but it really wasn't just about "breaking rules", Jesus was teaching something much bigger and the Pharisees just weren't getting it.

The Pharisees were all about outward appearances and following rules which put undue burden on the people but Jesus was teaching that the purpose of God's Law was to show man how to live Holy, like He did, NOT for the punishment of man for not doing so. Of course we also mentioned the secondary purpose was to show us that it is impossible for man to live Holy on our own. We need Jesus.

Jesus told the Pharisees that the Sabbath (rest) was made for man, not man for the Sabbath (Mark 2:27). The Pharisees were missing the whole point of the Sabbath. God's 4th Commandment to rest on the Sabbath should be a blessing for us to have REST in Him from our work all week but the Pharisees instead turned it into a burden for man with all their additional rules and punishments.

We said that Jesus is teaching something much bigger than just following laws. He's teaching us the purpose of God's Law is to show us to Love God & Love others, with all your heart, the rest will come later.
